

Press Pack: Facts & Figures

National Plant Collections

- There are over **650** National Plant Collections covering genera from Abies to Zingiber and containing over **95,000** garden plants. They come in all sizes, from miniature orchids to mighty oaks, and are found in all corners of the country.
- These are cared for and nurtured by **almost 400 Collection Holders** across the country, including:
 - 230 (35%) collections are held by private individuals
 - 123 (19%) are in specialist plant nurseries
 - 91 (14%) in botanic gardens and arboreta, including Royal Botanic Gardens Kew and The National Arboretum
 - 66 (10%) in smaller gardens/charitable trusts, including
 - 48 (7%) in National Trust and National Trust for Scotland properties, including Wimpole Hall (Cambridgeshire), Powis Castle (North Wales) and Brodick Castle (Ayrshire & Arran)
 - 48 (7%) in governmental or local authority organisations, including Sir Harold Hillier Gardens, Leeds City Council and West Ham Park
 - 24 (4%) in education establishments such as universities and colleges, including
 Cambridge University Botanical Garden, University of Reading and the Eden Project
 - 13 (2%) are in RHS gardens, including RHS Garden Wisley
 - 9 (1%) held by zoos, including Bristol Zoological Gardens and Paignton Zoo
- 28 new collections were accredited in 2019
