NOTES

***Geum* 'Abendsonne'**



Upward facing double bright orange/ yellow flowers with frilly petals. Height 20-30cm.

***Geum* 'Alabama Slammer' (Cocktails Series)**



***Geum* 'Apricot Pearl' (Censation Series)**



Large semi double flowers, 4cm in diameter. The petals are pale pinky orange over a cream base. The bright red calyx acts as a contrast.

Height 52cm. Spread 36cms.

A strong healthy plant with stems that stand up well. Flowered for 5 weeks from the beginning to the end of May.

***Geum* 'Apricot Sundae'**



Single bowl shaped flowers. At first the petals are tinged with soft orange but later this turns pink over a cream base. Height 10cm. Spread 18cm.

***Geum* 'Bachelfe'**



Drooping flowers with pale yellow/white petals almost completely enclosed by similarly coloured calyx. The fruits, (shown in image) which are achenes, are attractive in themselves. In many respects this is a thug, spreading to about a metre - good for groundcover. Can flower from early April to late May. Height 60cm.

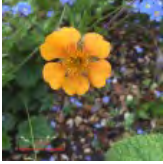

Geum 'Beech Park Apricot'



Single golden yellow flowers which are upward facing.
Flower diameter 3.5cm. Height 22cm. Spread 20cm.
Typically flowers for the entirety of May.

Geum 'Beech's Double'



Similar to Geum 'Bell Bank' but with bigger more double flowers. Salmon pink petals contrast with yellow stamens.
Flower diameter 3.5cm. Height 28cm. Spread 28cm.

Geum 'Bell Bank'



Drooping double flowers with frilly petals, which are pale pink on the inside and deeper pink on the outside. The flowers gradually become flat and outward facing as they mature.
An old cultivar, vigorous and floriferous.
Flower diameter 1.5cm, Height 48cm. Spread 50cm.

Geum 'Birkhead's Creamy Lemon'



Geum 'Blazing Sunset'



Large double deep red flowers - 4cm diameter. Upright stems, approx 80cm, often divide into 3, the terminal flower opening first. Does well in sun. Can flower from the end of April to early June, with the occasional blooms into August.

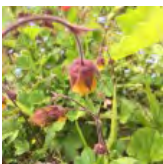

Single drooping flowers. Deep golden yellow. Height 30cm.

***Geum* 'Bremner's Nectarine'**



The name describes the colour of the large single flowers - up to 4cm diameter. Clump forming. The tall stems approx 80cm stand up well.

***Geum* 'Butterscotch'**



Deep orange cup-shaped flowers with some deeper orange splashes on the petals. A small, low growing plant which makes an impact with its bright flowers whether in sun or part shade. Flower diameter 3cm. Height 20cm. Spread 16cm.

***Geum* 'Can Can'**



Large very double flowers, diameter 3cm. Golden yellow with red splashes. Height 20cm.

Large single buttercup yellow flowers, up to 4cm diameter. Quickly develops large surface rhizomes. Height 30 - 40cm. Spread 15cm.

A chiloense type with bright orange double flowers on very tall stems which are inclined to sprawl.

Flower diameter 5cm. Height 60 cm.

Large double flowers with yellow base colour tinged with various shades of orange. Reverse of petals more yellow contrasting with a deep red calyx.

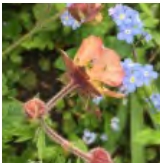


***Geum* 'Cotton Candy'**



A very floriferous spreading cultivar with open, drooping, single flowers. The pale pink petals are frilly and widely spaced. The dark red calyces and stems provide an attractive contrast.

***Geum* 'Country Rock'**



Single, bowl shaped flowers, with the petals separated at the base. Creamy orange background with deeper red colouring on the veins and edges.

Flower diameter 2.5cm. Height 26cm. Spread 20cm.

***Geum* 'Cream Crackers'**



***Geum* 'Cumbrian Candy'**



Semi-double drooping flowers. The petals are soft yellow inside and pink/orange on the outside contrasting with the bright red calyces.

Flower diameter when fully open 2cm.

Height 23cm. Spread (after 2 years) 35cm.

***Geum* 'Custard Tart'**



Bright lemon yellow petals which slightly overlap. Orange stamen. The stems and calyces are pale green.

Flower diameter 2.5 cm. Height 35cm. Spread 30cm.

***Geum* 'Dawn'**



A seedling selected at Brickwall Cottages in 2009 and which has performed consistently well ever since. A strong spreading plant with drooping double flowers. The petals are golden yellow inside and streaked with orange on the outside.

It does well in semi-shade flowering for 8 weeks from early April until the end of May.

Flower diameter 3cm. Height 50cm. Spread over 1 metre.

A long established cultivar and plants sold under this name vary considerably. Originally described as 'bearing a profusion of large semi-double flowers, glowing deep orange'. It stands out in a border with strong branching stems and will flower in sun or part shade.

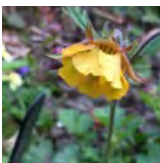
Large saucer-shaped flowers. The petals are frilly, cream in the centre becoming soft pink at the edges and are separated at the base. Diameter of flower 4 cm. Height 20 cm.

Geum 'Eden Valley Angel'



White semi-double drooping flowers with a touch of pink in the frilly petals. The dark red calyx makes a strong contrast spread over the back of the petals. Stems brown. Leaves round. Height 23cm. Spread 40cm. Flower diameter 2.5 cm.

Geum 'El Wano'



A strong plant with a mass of semi-double golden yellow flowers with orange markings and conspicuous red calyces. Drooping then outward facing. Flower diameter 4cm. Height 30cm.

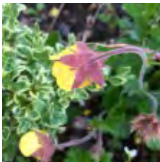


***Geum* 'Fancy Frills'**



Double flowers with very frilly petals which are cream with pink edges. Calyx and stems are dark red.

***Geum* 'Farmer John Cross'**



A long standing cultivar, it was introduced in 1990. Distinctive bright yellow drooping flowers with red calyces.

A useful ground covering plant, will do well in shade or semi-shade.

Height approx 40cm.

Large double frilly dark orange flowers with frilly edges. The stiff stems stand up well.
Flower diameter 4-5 cm. Height 50cm.

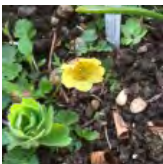
Small single, occasionally semi double, burnt orange flowers. Although the flowers are only 2-3cm across they are distinctive in their unusual colour. Calyx soft green. Stems red/brown.
Height 60cm

Geum 'Flames of Passion'^{PBR}



The latest acquisition is the first one to survive over the winter. It is a small low growing plant with double drooping pink/red flowers. In full sun it flowered for 6 weeks from mid April to late May. The plant in a raised bed in semi shade did not survive.
Flower diameter 3cm. Height 30cm.

Single lemon yellow cup shaped flowers, diameter 2cm. Calyx green base, red tips. Stems red/brown. Height of stems 7cm.

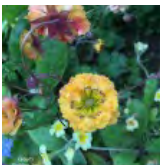
Geum 'Gimlet' (Cocktails Series)



One of the Cocktail Series raised in the USA this has done relatively well in a sunny position but overshadowed by other plants.

It has double, cool-yellow, frilly upward-facing flowers, diameter 2cm. Calyx and stems are red. Height 30cm. Spread after one year 25 x 20cm.

Geum 'Golden Joy'



An excellent introduction from DK Plants this has done well in a shady position.

Saucer-shaped, double frilly golden yellow flowers, drooping at first but becoming upward facing. Calyx and stems dark brown.

Flower diameter 3cm. Height 25 cm. Spread 22 x 16cm.

Geum 'Hannay's'



This has been in the Collection since 2008 and has performed consistently well.

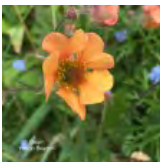
A spreading plant bearing a mass of soft orange cup-shaped flowers, drooping at first becoming upward facing as they mature.

Flower diameter 3-4cm. Height 30cm.

Geum 'Herterton Primrose'

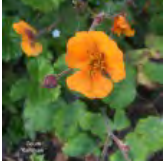
An excellent plant. The strong tall stems radiate from a central point bearing soft orange single and double flowers with deep pink veins and edges. It is planted in several places in the garden and does equally well in all conditions.

The flowers are 4cm across and the stems (green at base, becoming deep red) up to 80cm tall.

Single light orange cup-shaped flowers with darker markings in the centre. Calyx red overlying dark green. Epicalyx very visible. Stems dark red. A resilient long lived plant suitable for the front of a border in semi-shade.

Flower diameter 3cm. Height 25cm.

Lots of small double golden yellow flowers with frilly petals on strong upright stems. Calyx and stems green. A very popular cultivar which first gained an Award of Garden Merit in 1921.

Flower diameter 3cm. Height up to 70cm.

Large single acid yellow flowers which droop at first and then face upwards. The red calyces make a good contrast.

Flower diameter 3.5 cm. Height 40 cm.

Geum 'Little Twister'

Large single flowers. The frilly cream petals have pink colouring on the veins and edges. Dark brown calyces and stems make a good contrast.
Flower diameter 3cm. Height 32 cm. Spread after one year 30cm.

Geum 'Magic Toybox'



Double drooping flowers with peach/pink frilly petals.
Flower diameter 3 cm. Height 26 cm. Spread 30x30 cm.
The flowers on the plant in a poor situation surrounded by box hedges were larger and more plentiful than those on the plant in an open bed with better soil. Both in some sun and some shade.

Geum 'Mai Tai'^{PBR} (Cocktails Series)



A popular plant with attractive large double flowers, the frilly petals are pink/orange on the inside, cream on the outside. One of the Cocktail Series this has fared better than most. Of the 3 planted in the garden the one in full sun flowered well, the one in shade didn't flower at all, and the one in a raised bed surrounded by other Geums, died in the winter.
Flower diameter 4cm. Height 30cm.

Geum 'Mandarin'



One of the best *chiloense* types with large double outward facing flowers on strong stems. It does well in sun or partial shade.
Flower diameter 4.5cm. Height in the region of 60cm.
It can flower continuously from early March to June with occasional flowers well into late summer.

Introduced by Marchant's Hardy Plants this is a low growing plant with drooping flowers that are more pink than apricot. The diameter of the flowers when fully open is 2cm. Height 25-30cm.

This has proved to be a robust free flowering plant for shade. The drooping flowers are soft pink with a contrasting dark red calyx. Flower diameter 2cm. Height 18cm.

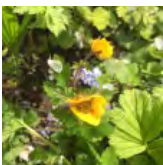

Golden yellow single flowers which droop at first but become upward facing as they mature. The flowers are small, diameter 1.5cm, but show up well due to their intense colour. Height 20cm.

Drooping pale pink / cream flowers with darker pink calyces which enclose the petals Flower diameter 2cm. Height 25 - 30 cm.
Flowering time in sun/dappled shade typically 2 weeks at the end of April.

***Geum* 'Nonna'**



Double flowers with frilly golden yellow petals which are a deeper red/orange at the edges. Although a small plant it was very striking with a mass of flowers for 6 weeks from mid April to end of May. Calyx dark red. Prominent epicalyx. Stems dark red.
Flower diameter 3cm. Height 16cm.

The drooping flowers are a soft yellow, the petals being enclosed by a pale green calyx.
Flower diameter 1cm. Height 20cm.

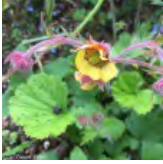


***Geum* 'Pink Petticoats'**



Double semi drooping flowers. Pale pink undertone with deeper pink splashes on the outer petals. The reddish/brown calyx makes a good contrast with prominent epicalyces. Flower diameter 4.5cm. Height 30cm. Spread after one year 30cm. Very similar to Beech's Double with slightly larger flowers. Extremely floriferous.

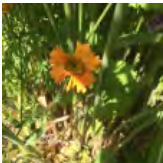

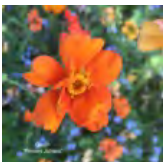

***Geum* 'Prinses Juliana' AGM**



Probably imported into this country from Holland in the 1940s, this was one of the first Geums included in the Collection. It has deep orange double flowers with frilly petals and a green calyx on stiff green stems. Flower diameter 5cm. Height typically 60cm, up to 74cm max. It flowered from 5 - 6 weeks depending on how overshadowed it was by other plants. All situations were potentially sunny with shade at certain times of day.

Semi-double soft orange flowers on strong stems approximately 30cm high.

***Geum* 'Red Dragon'**



Large double bright red flowers. It does appear to come true from seed but is not a long lived plant. Flower diameter 5cm. Height up to 60cm.

***Geum* 'Red Wings'**



A long lived reliably floriferous plant with large double bright red flowers. Flower diameter 5cm. Height 60cm.

***Geum* 'Rijnstroom'**



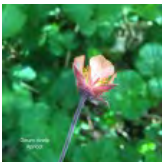
Large open single or double soft orange flowers up to 6cm in diameter. Calyx and stem green. Height 55cm. Slow to bulk up.

***Geum rivale* 'Album'**



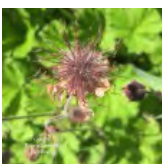
Drooping flowers with creamy/white petals almost completely enclosed by the calyx. The plant spreads by rhizomes making good evergreen ground cover. Flower diameter 1cm. Height up to 50cm. Needs a lot of watering in very hot weather.

***Geum rivale* 'Apricot'**



Almost the same as *rivale* 'Marmalade'. *Geum rivale* 'Apricot' is slightly deeper orange and *Geum rivale* 'Marmalade' has more red on the petals. Both have drooping flowers with contrasting dark red calyces and stems. Flower diameter 2 - 3 cm when fully open. Height 50cm.

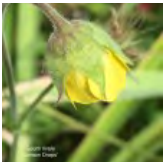


Drooping flowers with deep pink petals. The calyxes and stems are very dark red/brown making a striking contrast. Good ground cover.
Flower diameter 2cm. Height 40cm.

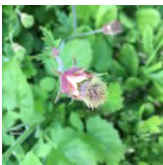


Small drooping flowers, the pale yellow petals being almost covered by the calyx at first, more of the petals becoming visible as the flower matures. Discovered by Beth Chatto in her garden.
Flower diameter 1cm. Height 25cm.
Flowering time 5 weeks from late April to late May.

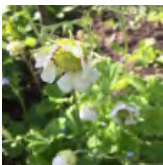

Vigorous rivale type geum with drooping single white flowers.
The green calyx spreads out around the petals.
Green stems and round notched leaves.
Flower diameter 3cm. Height 30cm. Spread 25cm.

***Geum* 'Rubin'**



Perhaps the best chiloense type, hardly ever without some flowers.
Bright red double flowers are held upright on stiff stems.
Flower diameter 5cm. Height 60 cm.

The only problem with this plant is that it bulks up very slowly so is seldom available.

Bright lemon yellow petals with orange/ red streaks on the back of petals. Bright red calyx and dark brown stems. Drooping flowers on slowly spreading plants.
Flower diameter 2 - 3 cm. Height 40cm.

Flower diameter 2cm. Height 40cm.

Drooping bowl-shaped soft orange single flowers.
This is invariably the first Geum to flower. Starts flowering typically in mid March and continues until the end of May in shade.
Flower diameter when fully open up to 3cm. Height 45cm.

Soft orange rather scruffy looking double flowers. The 40cm long stems are inclined to flop so best grown among other plants to keep it upright.

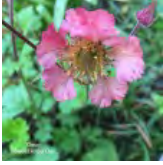

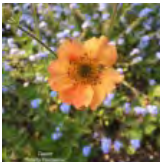

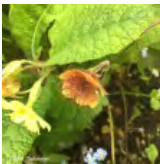


Geum 'Totally Tangerine'^{PBR}



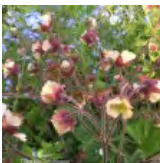
Almost the most popular Geum to have been introduced in recent years. Large semi-double or single bright orange flowers are born in profusion on stiff stems, no staking required!
Flower diameter 4cm. Height up to 60cm.

Geum 'Turbango'



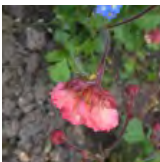
Small drooping deep/orange flowers. The calyx and stem are bright red making an interesting contrast.
Flower diameter 1cm. Height 12cm. Spread after one year 26x26 cm.

Large bowl-shaped drooping creamy yellow flowers with red veins and edges to the petals. Contrasting red calyx and red stems.
Flower diameter 3cm. Height 18cm.

Semi-double creamy yellow flowers with traces of red at the base of the petals, along the edges and veins.
Flower diameter 2.5cm. Height 24 cm.

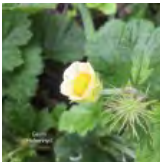
