# **National Plant Collections**

- There are around **700** <u>National Plant Collections</u> covering genera from *Abies* to *Zingiber* and containing over **95,000** garden plants. They come in all sizes, from miniature orchids to mighty oaks, and are found in all corners of the country.
- These are cared for and nurtured by over 400 Collection Holders across the country
  - 37% collections are held by private individuals
  - 18% are in specialist plant nurseries
  - 13% in botanic gardens and arboreta, including Royal Botanic Gardens Kew and The National Arboretum
  - **10%** in smaller **gardens/charitable trusts**
  - 7% in governmental or local authority organisations, including Sir Harold Hillier Gardens, Leeds City Council and West Ham Park
  - 6% in National Trust and National Trust for Scotland properties, including Wimpole Hall (Cambridgeshire), Powis Castle (North Wales) and Brodick Castle (Ayrshire & Arran)
  - 4% are in RHS gardens Wisley, Hyde Hall, Rosemoor, Bridgewater and Harlow Carr
  - 3% in education establishments such as universities and colleges, including Cambridge University Botanical Garden, University of Reading and the Eden Project
  - 1% held by zoos, including Chester Zoo and Paignton Zoo
  - 1% held by community groups
- 40 new collections were accredited in 2023
