Upward facing double bright orange/yellow flowers with frilly petals.
Height 20-30cm.

***Geum* 'Blazing Sunset'**



A striking variety that produces fully double scarlet flowers, measuring up to 5-6cm across, featuring a distinct ring of yellow stamens at the centre. Height up to 60cm. Grows best in full sun. An excellent cut flower.

***Geum* 'Blood Orange'**



***Geum* 'Borisii'**



Borisii is a clump-forming perennial that grows to a height of 30+cm. From late spring until mid-summer, it produces brilliant terracotta-orange, single flowers with prominent yellow stamens. This variety requires full sun and dislikes waterlogged conditions.

***Geum coccineum* 'Cooky'**



A neat, clump-forming perennial which produces single, bright orange, upward-facing flowers that are approximately 4cm across. Slender stems can reach a height of 45cm. Preferred growing conditions are full sun with moist, well-drained soil.

***Geum coccineum* 'Eos'**



A clump-forming perennial featuring small, rich orange flowers carried on stems approximately 30cm in height. Its most attractive and distinguishing feature is the foliage, which opens in a bright yellow colour before maturing to a lime green. In terms of care, it prefers moist but well-drained soil and thrives in either full sun or partial shade.

***Geum coccineum* 'Koi'**



A compact plant that reaches a height of approximately 25cm and produces dainty, bright orange-red flowers. For the best results, it prefers a position in full sun with moist, free-draining soil.

***Geum coccineum* 'Queen of Orange'**



Produces intensely coloured single orange flowers, up to 4cm across, on sturdy, upright stems. The mature height is approximately 45cm. This plant thrives in full sun or partial shade but requires moist, well-drained soil.

***Geum coccineum* 'Tango'**



A compact plant with stems reaching up to 40cm in height. It produces upward-facing single flowers in a bright orange hue. For best results, position in full sun with free-draining soil.

***Geum coccineum* 'Werner Arends'**



This plant produces rich orange, semi-double flowers with a centre of gold stamens. It blooms abundantly from late spring, with stems reaching a height of approximately 35cm. Regarding care, it can be grown in full sun or partial shade and thrives in moist but well-drained soil.

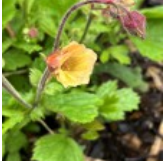

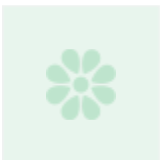

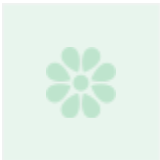

This is a strong chiloense variety known for its long flowering period from May to July. The plant features tall, airy, and slender stems reaching up to 80cm, bearing double flowers in soft orange with pink edges. This plant prefers moist but well-drained soil. While it thrives in full sun, it will also tolerate partial shade.

***Geum* 'Lemon Delight'**



A slow-growing, clump-forming perennial that will eventually reach 30cm in height. It produces lemon-yellow, frilly-edged flowers that fade to a pale creamy yellow between April and June. For optimal growth, it requires moist, free-draining soil and can be positioned in either full sun or partial shade.

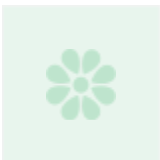

***Geum* 'Rijnstroom'**



***Geum rivale* 'Album'**



This rivale variety produces delicate, creamy-white, bell-shaped flowers up to 2cm across, which hang from arching stems that can reach a height of 45cm. For the best results, it should be planted in moist, well-drained soil and kept in partial shade.

***Geum rivale* 'Apricot'**



This variety features deep apricot-coloured, single, drooping flowers with bright red calyces and reaches a height of approximately 45cm. For the best results, it should be planted in moist, well-drained soil and kept in partial shade.

***Geum rivale* 'Barbara Lawton'**



This is a robust plant that reaches up to 40cm in height. It features dark red/brown buds that open to reveal drooping flower heads with pretty, frilly, salmon-pink petals. In terms of care, the plant thrives in moist soil conditions and can be placed in either full sun or partial shade.

***Geum rivale* 'Cream Drop'**



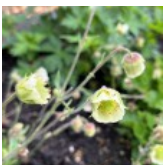
This is a compact, clump-forming perennial that features nodding, pale yellow/cream flowers with red calyces. It also bears distinctive red stems that can reach a height of up to 45cm. This plant thrives in full sun or partial shade but requires moist, well-drained soil.

***Geum rivale* 'Deep Rose'**



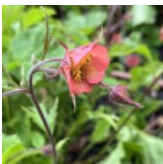
This shade-loving perennial requires moist, free-draining soil. It features red stems that can reach up to 40cm in height, and it produces beautiful bell-shaped flowers with deep rose-pink petals enclosed by hairy red calyces.

***Geum rivale* 'Elfenbein'**



A compact perennial that features yellowish-white flowers enclosed by pale green calyces. This plant thrives in a moist, cool spot and requires free-draining soil to grow successfully.

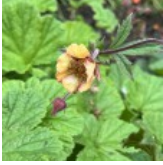
A compact, clump-forming perennial that grows to a height of approximately 40–45cm. Its bell-shaped flowers are deep coppery pink, semi-double and held in maroon calyces. It grows well in partial shade in moist, free-draining soil.

***Geum rivale* 'Marika'**



A strong plant that produces an abundance of flowers with deep pink petals. The stems are a distinctive dark red/brown and can reach a height of up to 70 cm. It thrives particularly well in damp areas with partial shade and serves as an excellent cut flower.

***Geum rivale* 'Marmalade'**



This plant features light orange flowers with lightly veined petals and hairy brown or reddish stems that grow to approximately 40 cm in height. It thrives best in water-retentive soil and partial shade.

***Geum rivale* 'Snowflake'**



This low-growing, clump-forming perennial features pale ivory single flowers and reaches a height of approximately 40 cm. It thrives best in moist, free-draining soil in partial shade.

'Tales of Hex' is a stunning plant. It's a semi-evergreen perennial with double, frilly flowers in a soft white/lemon colour with greenish centres. It reaches a height of approximately 25cm. This variety is easy to grow and thrives in moist but well-drained soil in full sun or partial shade.
